We take an upper cervical care approach to care because the alignment of the head and neck plays a large role in how a patient's back feels overall. We correct spinal imbalances by studying the upper neck. Most low back pain symptoms respond favorably to upper cervical chiropractic care.?

For patients with a disc injury, our chiropractors may suggest spinal decompression sessions to help heal the injury. The DRX9000 Non-Surgical Decompression Technology is the gold-standard in decompression and is a non-invasive, non-surgical treatment that requires no downtime and is highly recommended for relieving lower back pain.

The lower portion of the back, which is the lumbar spine, is typically composed of five vertebral bones with intervertebral discs in between the bones. The lumbar vertebrae are connected in the back of the spine with paired faced joints, which enable the person to move freely while also offering stability. Unfortunately, these joints degenerate with age, which weakens the cartilage lining the joint surfaces.

There are a number of ways the lower back can be injured, such as trauma, lifting heavy objects, poor posture, repetitive moves, and engaging in a new activity. Patients at Intouch Chiropractic have experienced substantial improvements with regards to their lower back pain within the first month of care. Their doctors offer a combination of upper cervical chiropractic care, spinal decompression and cold laser treatments.
