They want to stress, however, that the treatment they provide is for non-life threatening health issues, such as: burns; abrasions; bites; cut or laceration, needing stitches; wound follow-up, wound recheck, dressing change, and removal of sutures; back discomfort; childhood illness such as pink eye, rashes, or eye symptoms; impetigo; cold symptoms such as fever, cough, or sore throat; fractured bone; diarrhea; ear pain or infection; fish hook removal; injury of the ankle, knee, foot, wrist, elbow, or hand; joint pain; sunburn; muscle injury ? pull, strain, sprain; sports physicals; sinus pain or infection; full lab services; rash; urinary tract infection; vaginal discharge; x-rays; and other minor health issues.

They advise patients or their loved ones to call 911 or go to the emergency department of the hospital or clinic for serious and life-threatening health problems. These include: severe bleeding that won't stop; serious difficulty breathing; change in mental status (such as unusual behavior, confusion, or difficulty arousing); chest pain; choking, coughing or vomiting blood; fainting or loss of consciousness; burns or smoke inhalation; head or spine injury; severe or persistent vomiting or diarrhea; sudden injury due to motor vehicle injury; near drowning; feelings of wanting to harm oneself or others; a deep or large wound; sudden dizziness, weakness or change in vision; swallowing a poisonous substance; abdominal pain; carbon monoxide exposure; sudden blindness or severe eye injury; vaginal bleeding (non-pregnancy); partial or full paralysis; pregnancy related problems; and sexual assault.
