



Dr. Mark Hickman Says a Vasectomy Can Be Reversed at All-Inclusive Affordable Costs

Both microsurgical options are all-inclusive, which means there are no hidden fees.

Dr. Hickman has expertise in laparoscopic procedures and has even invented a number of surgical instruments, has received a U.S. patent and gained recognition as a contributor of a number of vital minimally invasive inventions. Dr. Hickman will look for the two ends of the vas deferens and free them from the surrounding scar tissue. He will then perform a microsurgical repair of the vas using an operating microscope and 10-0 nylon suture, which is thinner than human hair. He will carefully align the lumen of the two ends of the vas and create a watertight closure. Before performing the closure, he will first take a sample fluid from the testicular end of the vas deferens. Since the testicles don't stop producing sperm even after the vasectomy, the fluid should contain some sperm. In some cases, whole sperm may be found in the fluid, but it is more common to find sperm parts.

A third possibility is that the sample fluid doesn't contain sperm or sperm parts. The third case is indicative of an epididymal blowout, which means there is a blockage either at the vasectomy site or there is a rupture of the vas in the epididymis. In this case, Dr. Hickman will have to perform a vasoepididymostomy in addition to the vasovasostomy. It should be pointed out that despite the need to perform two procedures, there will be no additional cost because the price quoted is all-inclusive.

Started in 1988, Dr. Mark Hickman's practice benefits from his pioneering microsurgical and minimally invasive methods for vasectomy reversal. He finished his general surgery residency training at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio and it was during this period that he learned about the microsurgery methods that were then being applied in cosmetic and reconstructive surgery. He immediately recognized the different advantages that minimally invasive microsurgery can offer his patients, so he decided to use such methods in his vasectomy reversal practice. Dr. Hickman is also inviting patients from other parts of the US to come to New Braunfels.
