Medicare supplement insurance plans or Medigap plans are accepted by all Medicare providers. These plans

can help cover a percentage of the costs that are beyond those paid by Medicare. It is important to note that healthcare providers don't have to bill the Medicare supplement provider directly. Instead, they will simply need to bill Medicare. Medicare will be paying its share, which is typically 80 percentage of Medicare-covered benefits. It will then send the remainder of the bill, which is usually 20 percent, to the supplement provider.

Mike Hagan wants to point out that there are a number of things seniors need to know about Medigap policies or Medicare supplement plans. First of all, the applicant must have Medicare Part A and Part B. Second, a Medigap plan is different from a Medicare Advantage Plan. The latter offers ways to get Medicare benefits while Medigap is only designed to supplement original Medicare benefits. Third, the plan holder will need to pay the private insurance company a monthly premium in addition to the monthly Part B premium paid to Medicare.

Fourth, a Medigap policy will only cover one individual. Thus, couples will need to purchase separate Medigap policies. Fifth, a Medigap policy can be bought from any insurance company that is licensed to sell one in one's particular state. Sixth, any standardized Medigap policy is guaranteed to be renewed even if the plan holder has health issues. This implies that the insurance company cannot cancel the policy as long as the premium is being paid.

Seventh, while some Medigap policies in the past included prescription drug coverage, Medigap policies sold after January 1, 2006 are no longer able to do so. Eighth, those who want a prescription drug plan (Part D) will need to purchase a separate policy. Lastly, it is not legal to sell a Medigap policy to those who have a Medicare Advantage Plan, unless the policyholder plans to return to original Medicare.

Prescription Drug (Part D) insurance plans are designed to add drug coverage to original Medicare, some Medicare cost plans, some Medicare private-fee-for-service plans, and Medicare medical savings account plans. Each prescription drug plan has its own list of prescription drugs that it covers. This list is known as a formulary. Many of these prescription drug plans place these drugs into different "tiers" on their formularies. Drugs in each tier has a different cost.
