to go to when getting the market value of the property for property taxation, home financing, and legal issues.

In the province of Ontario in Canada, real estate agents and appraisers are under the control of certain governing bodies. For real estate agents, it is the Real Estate Council of Ontario (RECO), while for appraisers, it is the Appraisal Institute of Canada (AIC) or another recognized appraisal organization. The AIC sets the industry standards for property appraisal in Canada and appraisers need to comply with strict ethical guidelines and employ certain methodologies when determining real estate property values. They can offer detailed, well-documented reports that are vital for a number of financial and legal purposes.

RECO is the one that oversees the licensing of real estate agents in Ontario, including Brampton, and regulates their actions. While real estate agents can offer general estimates of the market value of a property, they are not qualified to provide formal property appraisals. Thus, in order to avoid conflicts of interests and ensure the accuracy of market valuations, real estate agents should be referring their clients to a professional appraiser when there is a need for a more accurate property valuation.

It is important to note that while real estate agents cannot provide formal property appraisals, they can provide informal valuations to their clients to give them a general idea of the property's market value. These informal valuations are known as comparative market analyses (CMAs), which can be helpful during the initial phases of buying or selling a property. Compared to professional appraisals, CMAs are not as accurate and comprehensive.

The article concludes that, while real estate agents play a vital role in helping real estate buyers and sellers, they are not really qualified to provide formal property appraisals. In contrast, property appraisers are experts when it comes to determining the market value of a real estate property and they are overseen by the AIC or some other recognized organization to make sure they keep the highest standards of ethics and professionalism.

While real estate agents can offer informal valuations through CMAs, for precise, legally-binding appraisals, it's advisable to consult a licensed appraiser who follows the established industry standards and guidelines."
