As opposed to expensive and inconvenient inpatient detox and recovery at a remote facility, New Life offers an intensive outpatient program so that patients can go through their treatment while staying at home and continuing to work or study. Its range of outpatient programs includes drug rehab, alcohol rehab, drug detox, alcohol detox, medication-assisted treatment (MAT), intensive outpatient programs (IOP), partial care (PC), traditional outpatient programs (OP), psychiatric & psychological counseling, peer counseling, group counseling, and ongoing patient monitoring.

Dr. Savon expounds on why IOP makes the most sense for the center's patients by saying, ?The IOP program can make a world of difference for those who have been afflicted with addiction as well as those living with co-occurring mental health concerns. It provides a much-needed holding environment for individuals seeking to build a firm foundation for a new way of living. Frequent contact with the center's professional practitioners provides individuals with brief periods of separation from former routines that resulted in alcohol or drug use. IOP services are also educational. Group participants develop a knowledge base about the disease of addiction and its manifestation as they collaborate with others who share a similar struggle. Their expanded emotional range then leads to greater affect tolerance which is a vital coping strategy to reduce the risk of relapse.?

New Life also employs the latest in telemedicine and advanced patient intake at its facility. The clinic's professionals are available for appointments either at the office or through Zoom or other remote telemedicine service providers. Moreover, the clinic's staff members are also available to help patients 24/7. New Life can take New Jersey Medicaid, and Medicare, and is in-network with Blue Cross Blue Shield Horizon addiction treatment.

The center's founder, Dr. Savon, has extensive experience in healthcare and leadership that speaks for itself. He has been a New Jersey Top Doc, a member of Who's Who, and an esteemed member of the New Jersey and Greater Philadelphia medical communities for over 35 years. After completing his medical degree at UMDNJ ?
