To help them acclimatise to the idea of moving abroad, it is recommended that parents engage in research about the destination alongside their children. This educational foray should touch on the new country?s culture, language, traditions, and so on. It is deeply recommended that children be given the opportunity and environment to learn the local language. This education can even begin well before the move, via online classes and so on.

No matter how much parents prepare, however, more help will inevitably be needed once they arrive. Fenn says it is best to find a support system in the new country as soon as possible, composed of other expat families or even online communities that are dedicated to expat parents in particular. Here, parents can discuss their children?s issues with people who have experienced such hurdles before, and their advice can go a long way.

On a more practical note, Fenn remarks that one of the best steps parents can take to help their children is to minimise their stress. ?Your children will be sensitive to your behaviour throughout the process,? she says. ?Their stress will be compounded by yours, so you can often help keep the whole family unit calm by making sure you have all the support you need. This can take many forms, including leaning on other family members and professional services that are designed to assist such transitions.?
