Dr. Hickman is a highly skilled microsurgical surgeon who focuses his entire practice on the successful reversal of vasectomies. He has performed over 1,300 vasectomy reversals throughout his 26-year-long career leading to thousands of births and happy new parents. Dr. Hickman pairs his religious mission with his expertise in microsurgery. An expert in laparoscopic procedures, he has invented several surgical instruments, has been awarded a U.S. patent, and is recognized as a contributor to several other important minimally invasive patents. He began his private practice in New Braunfels, TX in 1988 and soon after became an early pioneer of laparoscopic (minimally invasive telescopic) surgery.

Today, Dr. Hickman offers two all-inclusive affordable vasectomy reversal options. The microsurgical vasectomy reversal cost option of \$3,300 includes local anesthesia and an oral sedative. The \$4,200 offer is performed under IV sedation and is administered by a Board Certified Anesthesiologist. Both microsurgical options are all-inclusive with no hidden fees.

During the procedure, a small incision is made on each side of the scrotal skin under local anesthesia. The two ends of the vas deferens are then found and freed from the surrounding scar tissue. Dr. Hickman then does a microsurgical repair of the vas deferens using a Zeiss OPMI-MDM operating microscope utilizing a 10-0 nylon suture. The repair requires 10-15 stitches. The goal is to create direct and careful alignment of the lumen of the two ends of the vas and a watertight closure.

A sample of fluid from the testicular end of the vas deferens is placed on a glass slide and examined under a laboratory microscope. Since the testicle continues to produce sperm after a vasectomy, the fluid from the vas deferens could contain sperm. 3 possible situations may be encountered when examining the fluid sample.

Dr. Hickman explains the three scenarios by saying, ?The first and best situation is that the fluid will contain whole sperm. The second possible scenario, and more common, is that the fluid is thin and contains only sperm parts or no whole sperm. The third is that the fluid is thick, pasty, and contains no sperm. The last condition means that the vas is obstructed at two levels - at the vasectomy site and by rupture of the tube in the epididymis. So, in addition to a vasovasostomy, a vasoepididyostomy must be performed. At Microsurgical Vasectomy Reversals, there is no additional cost if both repairs must be performed.?
