During his visit to the capital on March 7th, Scott engaged in discussions with key stakeholders, emphasizing the program's transformative impact on Broadlinc's customers. ?I can now have telehealth with my doctors when I can?t go in to see them,? said Darrell, Monticello, KY.

?My children could do school work when they missed school because of Covid,? said Tosha, Owenton, KY.

?With ACP, I was able to get a package from Broadlinc that I normally couldn't afford,? said Christy, Milton, KY.

The potential end of the ACP in April raises concerns among customers about the future affordability of their internet service and the detrimental impact the loss of internet access will have on those affected. Voices from the community express apprehension about the impact on their budgets and their children's education, emphasizing the program's role in their lives.

In response to the potential program closure, Broadlinc is rallying support for its continuation. The company urges customers, community members, and stakeholders to voice the necessity of the ACP to policymakers.
