Homeowners can identify signs of rotted roof decking through observable indicators. Sagging or dipping areas on the roof can indicate that the decking has weakened or rotted due to moisture infiltration. Water stains or discoloration on the ceiling or walls inside the house can suggest that water has penetrated through the decking, causing decay. The presence of mold or mildew in the attic or along the underside of the roof can signal excess moisture and potential rot. If the roof shingles appear to be buckling or curling, it could be a result of compromised decking underneath.

The common causes of roof decking deterioration are due to moisture intrusion. Prolonged exposure to rain, snow, or humidity without proper ventilation or insulation can lead to moisture buildup and eventual rot. Leaks from damaged or improperly installed roofing materials can allow water to seep into the decking, accelerating decay over time.
