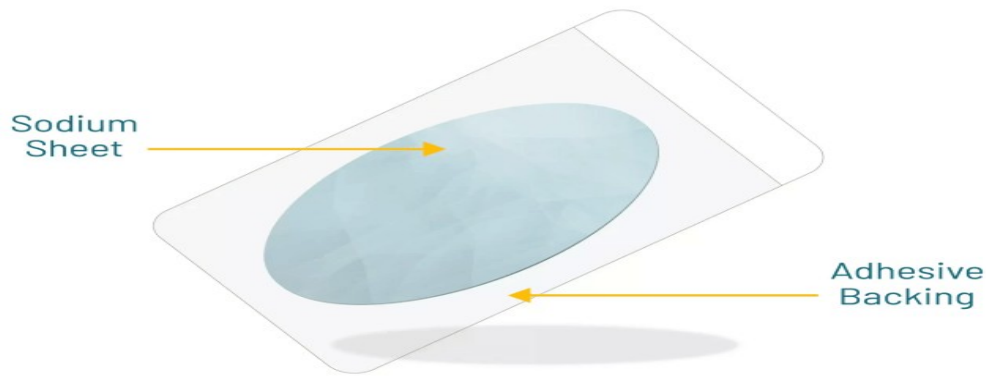

of days. The procedure is entirely non-invasive and painless, making it a comfortable experience: Dr. Kirby says that patients can expect to feel a bit of heat from the patch during treatment, as well as some tingling in the area, but it is tolerable without any numbing creams or injections.

The Brella underarm patch treatment has been shown in clinical trials to reduce sweat by up to 50%. The results are long-lasting, too, with reduced sweating for up to 3-4 months.

“Brella offers a quick application time, and does not require any needles, with similar effects to existing, more invasive, sweat reduction treatments,” explained Dr. Kirby. “This makes sweat treatment much more attainable for our patients, including those who have not been diagnosed with hyperhidrosis but who simply want to control underarm sweating. With the hot Texas summers we experience, this is an especially helpful solution for those who plan to enjoy outdoor concerts, weddings, festivals, and other events.”

The treatment works by utilizing sodium in the patch to react with sweat, temporarily deactivating the sweat glands and providing relief from excessive sweating. According to Dr. Kirby, Brella is safe and effective for all skin types and tones. Moreover, thermal energy treatments that target sweat glands require a lengthier treatment process, anesthetic, and restrictions after the procedure. They may even carry side effects like bruising, swelling, and tenderness. Brella, on the other hand, is a non-invasive solution with no pain, allowing patients to resume their daily activities immediately after treatment. This ease of use and minimal disruption to daily life make Brella a superior choice for many patients.
