LaMiNa is short for Laser skin resurfacing, Microneedling, and Nanofat grafting. Philadelphia plastic surgeon Dr. Claytor developed the technique, combining the benefits of CO2 laser skin resurfacing, which removes the outer layer of damaged skin and stimulates collagen production, with microneedling, which creates micro-injuries to further enhance collagen and elastin production. The addition of nanofat grafting, where processed fat from the patient's own body is applied to the skin, accelerates healing and improves skin texture and tone. The procedure enhances skin regeneration, leading to a smoother, more youthful complexion.

"LaMiNa provides incredibly effective facial anti-aging results," commented Dr. Claytor. "I've found that this combination is especially outstanding at reducing the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles around the mouth, which are notoriously difficult to treat without surgery."

Dr. Claytor's research on the LaMiNa technique has demonstrated its effectiveness in improving skin elasticity, reducing perioral wrinkles (around the mouth), and promoting overall facial rejuvenation. Patients who have undergone the procedure report significant improvements in skin texture and tone, with minimal discomfort and downtime when compared with a traditional facelift. This innovative approach has positioned Dr. Claytor as a leader in non-surgical facial rejuvenation, on top of his work in plastic surgery innovation.
