Tooth erosion is primarily caused by the frequent exposure of teeth to acidic foods and drinks, such as citrus

fruits, juices, sodas, sports drinks, and alcoholic beverages. Certain medications, when chewed or held in the mouth, can also contribute to erosion. Additionally, conditions like acid reflux disease (GERD), eating disorders, and frequent vomiting can expose teeth to stomach acid, leading to erosion.

The early stages of tooth erosion can be difficult to detect, as the changes to the teeth may be subtle. However, as the condition progresses, patients may notice increased sensitivity, discoloration, transparency at the edges of the front teeth, a rounded or "sand-blasted" appearance, and an increased susceptibility to cracks and chips.

To prevent or minimize tooth erosion, Art and Science Family Dentistry recommends limiting acidic foods and drinks, rinsing with water after consuming acidic substances, waiting at least 30 minutes before brushing teeth after consuming acidic substances, using a soft-bristled toothbrush, and considering a remineralizing toothpaste. If tooth erosion is suspected, it is essential to schedule an appointment with a dentist for proper diagnosis and treatment.

Although erosion itself does not cause cavities, it can make teeth more susceptible to decay. Children can also develop tooth erosion, particularly if they consume a diet high in acidic foods and drinks or have certain medical conditions.
