Brundage Mountain, according to Brown, has also made significant strides in developing its summer appeal. Their scenic chairlift rides and disc golf course add variety to the summer experience."

"What's particularly impressive about Brundage," Brown continued, "is how they've leveraged their natural assets. Mix in music and food trucks and Brundage offers a great get-a-way from downtown McCall?."

Sun Valley, long known as a premier ski destination, has successfully leveraged its reputation to become a year-round resort. "Sun Valley's transition to a four-season destination has been particularly impressive," Brown said. "From world-class golfing to outdoor concerts and festivals, they've created a summer experience that's every bit as appealing as their renowned winter season."

"Sun Valley's summer programming is extensive," Brown elaborated. "They host the Sun Valley Summer Symphony, one of the largest free-admission orchestras in America. Their gondola-accessed hiking and dining experiences offer a unique way to enjoy the mountain. And let's not forget their robust calendar of events, from writers' conferences to wellness retreats, which attract a diverse array of visitors."

The expansion into year-round operations isn't just beneficial for visitors, Brown emphasized. It also has significant economic impacts for the local communities.

"By extending their operational seasons, these resorts are creating more stable, year-round employment opportunities," Brown explained.
