This involves removing excess skin, tightening the surrounding tissue, and repositioning the nipple and areola complex to a higher, more youthful location on the chest wall. It's particularly beneficial for correcting breast ptosis, which results from factors such as aging, weight loss, and pregnancy.

For some individuals, simultaneously combining a breast lift with augmentation provides the optimal result, addressing both the size and position of the breasts for a comprehensive enhancement. Ultimately, selecting between a breast lift and augmentation or opting for a combination of the two depends on personal aesthetic goals, whether that means enhancing breast size, correcting breast ptosis, or both. Dr. Thornton specializes in tailoring each procedure to meet the individual desires and needs of his patients, ensuring a personalized and satisfying outcome.

There are differences in cost between a breast lift and breast augmentation. Generally, a breast lift tends to be more expensive than breast augmentation alone due to the complexity and length of the surgical procedure.
