Factors such as unstable vision, insufficient corneal thickness, ongoing eye diseases, severe dry eye syndrome, pregnancy, advanced glaucoma, or certain health conditions can affect eligibility. A detailed eye exam and health history review are essential to assess each patient's suitability for LASIK, or perhaps suitability for an alternate procedure such as PRK or SMILE. LVEI's thorough screening process ensures that only the most appropriate candidates undergo the procedure, thereby enhancing the likelihood of successful outcomes.

Las Vegas Eye Institute understands that hormonal changes, especially during pregnancy and breastfeeding,

can affect vision and LASIK timing. LVEI does not recommend LASIK for people who are pregnant or

breastfeeding and advise waiting at least three months after breastfeeding to consider the procedure. This

precaution helps ensure that vision changes due to hormonal fluctuations do not impact the success of

LASIK.

One concern for younger patients undergoing LASIK is the potential need for future adjustments if initial

vision stabilization is incomplete. Nearsighted people in their early 20s, for example, may continue to

experience slight increases in myopia. Las Vegas Eye Institute often makes minor alterations to the treatment

plan to decrease the risk of needing an enhancement, ensuring that the initial LASIK procedure provides

lasting benefits.

There is no strict upper age limit for LASIK at Las Vegas Eye Institute. Candidate suitability focuses on eye
