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"Cocaine is often sold in low quantities both due to its price and also because of the quantity needed to experience a high. Most often, cocaine is sold by its weight and is most commonly sold in grams. There aren't many other common terms for specific measurements of cocaine except for one. This term is a "bump" of cocaine and refers to a very small quantity of cocaine. A bump is enough for a single "hit" of cocaine and can be as little as 0.1 grams of cocaine. This is sometimes given out by dealers for free as a way for potential buyers to "test drive" the substance and increase the chances of buying," the blog post states.

To visualize what 3.5 grams looks like, it would be less than 1 teaspoon, approximately equivalent to 4 grams. An 8 ball of cocaine is often in powdered form, which means that it is a fine, white to off-white powder that is found in small, poly zip bags. The price of an 8 ball of cocaine varies like many other things in society. In 2010, the average cost in the United States was around \$84 per gram, while in 2021, it was around \$120 per gram. This would make in 2021, an 8 ball of cocaine cost around \$420. This increase in cost is like many other economic influences like groceries and rent. Drug dealers don't want to lose out on their profit, so if the cost of production goes up, they will raise their prices. The exact price of cocaine varies from state to state and town to town.

The side effects of an 8 ball of cocaine must first be established by understanding a common quantity of cocaine consumed in one sitting. A bump of cocaine is equal to one hit of cocaine. A single hit of cocaine is enough to experience the side effects of cocaine. An 8 ball of cocaine is equal to 35 hits of cocaine. Cocaine comes with many side effects like euphoria, increased energy, increased heart rate, decreased appetite, dilated pupils, and increased blood pressure. These can happen with small doses. With larger quantities like that found in an 8 ball of cocaine, there are more intense side effects that are possible, like paranoia, muscle twitches, vertigo, erratic behavior, and overdose. An overdose of cocaine can be life-threatening and requires medical help to reverse. The Good Samaritan Law prevents a person from being prosecuted for seeking medical help for a substance use-related incident.
