In studies, Suboxone treatment has been shown to improve outcomes for people with OUD substantially.

Medication is just one aspect of what MAT clinics do to help people. MAT is most effective when it?s used in combination with therapies, as stated above. MAT clinics also provide people with connections to other people who are working toward a life without opioids. This sense of community is important when you?re in recovery. Often, OUD feels very isolating. It can be difficult to believe that it?s not just you. There are people

in your community who have had similar experiences,? the article states.

MAT clinics support the recovery process beyond the medication and treatment options they offer. They also provide patients with access to other vital resources.

?Recovering from OUD impacts practically every aspect of someone?s life. That?s why, at ReVida® Recovery, we also set you up with a care coordinator who will connect you with additional resources like SNAP, housing, and employment opportunities. Your care coordinator can also help you deal with court letters, custody proceedings, and other legal issues related to substance use,? the article continues.

MAT saves lives, and ensuring that people have access to resources when they need them is a fundamental part of what makes MAT clinics so important.

Dispelling myths reduces the stigma around opioids and makes community spaces a safer place for people in recovery.
