Platinum and 18-karat gold are the primary metals used, chosen for their tensile strength and ability to retain finish over time.

In terms of design variety, Ginza Diamond Shiraishi offers several ring styles that accommodate different preferences while maintaining a core philosophy of harmony between form and function. From classic solitaire settings to rings with accent stones and geometric elements, the collections are organized to provide clarity during the selection process. Each ring is also available in men's and women's coordinated pairs, reinforcing the symbolic aspect of unity.

Customization options play a prominent role in the customer experience. Clients are able to adjust ring width, choose between different metal tones, and select specific diamond placements or engraving details.
