The surgery generally takes around three hours, and an overnight stay at the clinic may be recommended.

Recovery from breast reduction surgery is a gradual process. Patients can expect swelling and bruising, which typically subsides over weeks to months. Pain relief medication is provided, and supportive garments are worn. Light activities can often be resumed soon after surgery, though strenuous activities and heavy lifting should be avoided for several weeks. Dr. Stavrou provides detailed post-operative care instructions to facilitate healing and optimize results. While the results are generally long-lasting, significant weight changes, pregnancy, and aging can influence breast appearance.
