The company adheres to international frameworks for responsible diamond procurement, including conflict-free guarantees under the Kimberley Process. In addition, it actively maintains transparency with clients about diamond origins, grading, and certification. All diamonds are selected based on strict internal criteria that often go beyond standard certification requirements, with specific attention to light performance and cut precision.

In the Hong Kong showroom, clients are provided with the opportunity to view loose diamonds and examine sample rings prior to final selection. Each customer experience is structured around consultation and education, rather than sales. Staff undergo training to guide couples through the selection process, focusing on design preferences, lifestyle considerations, and long-term care. The showroom also offers digital magnification tools to assist in diamond evaluation and to help clients gain a better understanding of how clarity and cut affect visual impact.

Customization options are available across most ring designs. Clients may choose from multiple metal types, including platinum, white gold, rose gold, and yellow gold, as well as variations in finish, such as matte or mirror-polished surfaces. In addition, engraving services are available for those who wish to include names, dates, or messages on the interior of the band. Production times for made-to-order rings vary depending on design complexity but generally range between four and six weeks. Quality control checks are conducted at multiple stages of the production process, including final inspection under magnification to identify any surface or setting irregularities. Completed rings are packaged with documentation that includes diamond grading reports, care instructions, and warranty information.

To ensure long-term wearability, Ginza Diamond Shiraishi Hong Kong offers complimentary services such as resizing, cleaning, and periodic inspection. These services are designed to encourage regular maintenance

and to identify potential issues before they affect the structural integrity of the ring. Clients are encouraged to return annually for inspection, a practice that supports both sentimental preservation and practical upkeep.

The wedding ring collections offered in Hong Kong reflect the broader design language of the brand, which blends traditional motifs with contemporary refinement. Signature collections include names inspired by natural and celestial themes, with design elements that reference waves, leaves, stars, and seasons.
