?Dopamine plays a crucial role in the brain's reward center. Usually, dopamine is released when you're doing something you enjoy, like eating your favorite meal or spending an afternoon with your best friend. These high levels of dopamine make you want to repeat pleasurable activities.

?When you take opioids, the dopamine levels in your brain get so high that the amount your brain naturally produces doesn't compare. This causes the flu-like symptoms of withdrawal that occur when you stop taking opioids. In an attempt to avoid withdrawal symptoms and satiate the cravings that come with them, many people return to opioid use,? the website continues.

MAT is key to reducing withdrawal symptoms, like muscle aches, sinus issues, and gastrointestinal distress. The treatment also improves cravings, which empowers clients to avoid a return to use.
