This innovation is designed to reduce the common drawbacks patients sometimes report with other IOLs, such as halos, glare, or starbursts, particularly in low-light settings. Clinical data shows that most patients experience little to no bothersome visual disturbances after surgery. Many also report that they are able to enjoy routine daily activities without needing corrective eyewear—a significant quality-of-life improvement that aligns with the goals of most patients undergoing lens replacement.

Made from a glistening-free, hydrophobic acrylic material, the enVista Envy lens is engineered for clarity, durability, and scratch resistance. Its optical design is supported by ClearPath and TruSight technologies, which further enhance contrast and image sharpness, especially in challenging lighting conditions. These combined features help deliver a more natural and dependable visual experience that closely aligns with what

patients had when they were younger and had healthy, natural lenses. In ClearSight's clinical experience, the lens has become a preferred option for patients seeking visual freedom, particularly those who are active, work on screens, or want to reduce or eliminate the need for reading glasses or bifocals.
