These diamonds are selected for their light performance and craftsmanship, with attention given not only to brilliance but also to the alignment and balance of the optical pattern.

At the Ginza Diamond Shiraishi showroom in Hong Kong, clients receive access to an advisory experience that supports both emotional and practical aspects of ring selection. Consultations are held in private settings to allow time for detailed discussion around personal preferences, budget, lifestyle, and long-term care.
