Lex Wire Launches ?AI Visibility Profiles? to Help Lawyers Build Authority in Generative Search Results

The resulting content is enhanced with legal-specific structured data formats such as LegalService and NewsArticle schema, all of which are embedded into the profile's source code.

The profiles also include relevant quotes from the attorney, where applicable, and may feature highlights of media appearances, authored commentary, or CLE contributions. The profiles are hosted on LexWire.org, a neutral media domain distinct from promotional legal directories or marketing agency websites. "We created Lex Wire Journal as a way to future-proof attorneys' online authority," added Howell. With the proper schema and citations in place, legal professionals can improve their visibility in zero-click AI-generated answers, which are increasingly replacing standard search result lists.
