



## **Waste Away Services Brings Trusted and Affordable Dumpster Rental to East Texas Communities**

Waste Away Services, a Murchison, Texas-based waste management company, announced expanded service coverage across nine East Texas communities as of January 2025. The company now provides dumpster rental services to Tyler, Canton, Athens, Jacksonville, Lindale, Chandler, Bullard, Chapel Hill, and Palestine.

The expansion represents a geographic increase of approximately 150 miles in service diameter from the company's Murchison headquarters. This development follows increased construction permit activity across East Texas, with Tyler reporting a 12% rise in residential renovation permits during the last quarter of 2024, according to municipal records.

Waste Away Services offers two container sizes: 6-yard units for heavy materials and 20-yard units for mixed debris. The company reports processing an average of 75 container loads monthly across its service territory. Standard rental periods run seven days, with the company maintaining a fleet of 12 delivery vehicles to serve

the expanded region.

Local waste management needs in East Texas have grown alongside population increases. The Texas Demographic Center projects continued population growth of 2.3% annually for the region through 2030. Construction and demolition waste represents approximately 40% of landfill volume in East Texas municipalities, based on Texas Commission on Environmental Quality data.

The company operates under Texas Commission on Environmental Quality permits and maintains compliance with disposal regulations across multiple county jurisdictions. Each service area maintains distinct waste disposal ordinances, requiring coordination with local authorities in Smith, Henderson, Van Zandt, Cherokee, and Anderson counties.

Industry data indicates dumpster rental demand in Texas increased 8% year-over-year in 2024, driven by residential renovation projects and commercial construction. The East Texas region specifically experienced higher demand due to storm damage repairs following severe weather events in spring 2024.

Waste Away Services processes construction debris, residential waste, and yard materials through authorized disposal facilities. The company reports diverting approximately 20% of collected materials to recycling facilities when applicable. Heavy materials such as concrete and dirt comprise roughly 35% of total waste volume handled by the company.

Pricing structures in the dumpster rental industry vary significantly across providers. Waste Away Services implements inclusive pricing that incorporates delivery, pickup, and standard disposal fees. This approach contrasts with variable pricing models common in the industry where additional fees may apply based on distance, weight, or material type.

The East Texas expansion required additional equipment investment and regulatory approvals across multiple jurisdictions. The company obtained necessary permits and business licenses for each new service municipality between October and December 2024.

Competition in the regional waste management sector includes both national chains and local operators. Market analysis shows approximately 15 dumpster rental providers currently serve the Tyler metropolitan area, with fewer options available in smaller communities like Bullard and Chandler.

Municipal officials in several East Texas communities have noted increased demand for construction-related services as housing development accelerates. Palestine reported 47 new residential construction starts in the fourth quarter of 2024, while Athens approved 23 commercial renovation projects during the same period.

Waste Away Services schedules deliveries Monday through Saturday, with emergency service available for storm debris removal. The company's Murchison facility serves as the dispatch center for all regional operations. Container placement follows municipal guidelines regarding right-of-way restrictions and surface protection requirements.

Environmental considerations affect waste management operations throughout Texas. Landfill capacity, recycling infrastructure, and disposal costs influence service availability and pricing across the industry. East Texas facilities currently maintain adequate capacity for construction and demolition waste, though long-term planning remains a consideration for regional authorities.

The company's service expansion coincides with broader economic development initiatives across East Texas. Regional planning organizations project continued growth in construction activity, driven by both residential development and commercial investment in the Interstate 20 corridor.

Transportation logistics play a significant role in dumpster rental operations. Drive times from Murchison to the furthest service points approach 90 minutes, affecting scheduling and operational efficiency. The company reports maintaining service standards across all coverage areas despite geographic challenges.

As East Texas communities continue developing, waste management infrastructure must expand accordingly. Industry observers note that reliable dumpster rental services support construction activity, property maintenance, and disaster response capabilities throughout the region.
