



Local Rehab Releases Findings on MAT vs. Traditional Detox in Fight Against Opioid Crisis

With the center of the opioid crisis still looming, Appalachian residents are searching for options as far as recovery is concerned. While some choose traditional detox as their method for safely withdrawing from opioids, others are curious about medication-assisted treatment, or MAT, as a healing track.

“Most MAT treatment options use a medication to manage opioid cravings and other symptoms of withdrawal. With the help of MAT, you can avoid the most intense flu-like symptoms [of withdrawal] and instead focus on your recovery,” the article states. “Buprenorphine is one of the most common MAT medications. It’s a partial opioid agonist that works by attaching itself to opioid receptors, which means that you won’t experience the full effects of opioid withdrawal. Some MAT clinics use other medications, such as naltrexone and methadone, which are both approved by the Food and Drug Administration.”

While traditional detox and MAT are both viable options for aiding in the withdrawal process, MAT allows individuals to begin therapy a little sooner and focus on their recovery without the uncomfortable and

sometimes painful symptoms of walking away from opioids.

During traditional detox, you stop taking opioids and manage the symptoms of withdrawal without the medication used in MAT. Many people use over-the-counter medications, or those prescribed by a doctor, to treat individual symptoms such as nausea, difficulty sleeping, or muscle aches.

It is safest to do this with the support of medical professionals, who have experience working with people in recovery, so that the process is safer and more comfortable. Detoxing alone is risky. While some people do it, it's not recommended, says ReVIDA.

The guide continues to discuss how to determine whether MAT or traditional detox is the right choice for each person, emphasizing personal preference. Deciding between MAT and traditional detox depends on the goals for recovery. MAT is a good fit for those who want to limit the extent of withdrawal symptoms and cravings.

If you feel you can manage your withdrawal symptoms without medical intervention, traditional detox might be a better fit for you.

It's not a matter of what's right or wrong. It simply comes down to your personal preferences. Treatment doesn't end with traditional detox or MAT. Regardless of the route you choose, recovery is a big commitment, and you'll need support to be successful. Individual therapy empowers you to find the underlying causes of OUD, and a trusted therapist will work with you to find healthier coping mechanisms. Group therapy will enable you to make connections with others in recovery. You'll find a path toward healing, supporting each other through periods of adjustment and celebrating wins together.
