



Moment of Clarity Announces Introduction of Ketamine Therapy as Part of Comprehensive Anxiety Disorder Treatment

Outpatient mental health care continues to grow in importance across Southern California as communities face increasing demand for effective anxiety disorder treatment. Moment of Clarity's Long Beach location has become a focal point for addressing this need by offering evidence-based outpatient programs that target both symptoms and underlying causes of anxiety. The center provides structured levels of care, including Intensive Outpatient Programs (IOP), Partial Hospitalization Programs (PHP), and therapies such as Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), and Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR). These approaches reflect widely recognized clinical methods designed to help individuals manage anxiety more effectively.

The Long Beach facility serves a diverse population from surrounding neighborhoods and suburbs. Residents of Downtown Long Beach, Paramount, Los Altos, Carson, Lakewood, and Signal Hill regularly seek outpatient care in this region. Families in Bixby Knolls, California Heights, and Bluff Park also utilize services locally, demonstrating the need for accessible mental health treatment across both central and suburban areas of Los Angeles County.

Recent developments in treatment options have included the introduction of ketamine therapy, a modality that has been studied in clinical settings for treatment-resistant depression and anxiety. According to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, esketamine—a derivative of ketamine—was approved in 2019 for treatment-resistant depression, highlighting the potential of these therapies when administered in controlled medical environments. By integrating newer approaches alongside established therapies such as CBT and DBT, providers are aiming to create a continuum of care that reflects both current research and long-term clinical standards.

Programs at the Long Beach location are structured to balance treatment with daily responsibilities. The IOP model allows patients to continue working or managing family obligations while participating in therapy several times a week. PHP offers a higher level of daily care, including extended sessions and clinical monitoring, which can be particularly beneficial for individuals experiencing more severe or persistent anxiety symptoms.

Anxiety disorders are among the most common mental health conditions in the United States. Data from the National Institute of Mental Health shows that nearly one in three adults will experience an anxiety disorder at some point in their lives. In urban and suburban communities like Long Beach, outpatient programs play a central role in making treatment accessible to people who may not require residential care but need structured support and evidence-based therapies.

Therapies provided at the Long Beach facility align with clinical best practices. CBT focuses on identifying and reframing distorted patterns of thinking that contribute to anxiety. DBT emphasizes emotional regulation, distress tolerance, and mindfulness techniques that are effective for individuals managing intense anxiety responses. EMDR, often used for trauma-related anxiety, has been studied for its ability to reduce distress linked to past events that continue to trigger symptoms. By combining these modalities, outpatient programs create multi-dimensional treatment strategies that address both immediate challenges and long-term stability.

Community members across Los Angeles County have emphasized the importance of accessible care within their neighborhoods. For residents of Lakewood and Carson, outpatient treatment offers flexibility, enabling participation without requiring major disruptions to daily routines. In areas such as California Heights and Bluff Park, proximity to the Long Beach facility makes specialized therapies like EMDR and DBT available without the burden of long-distance travel.

The role of outpatient centers is also increasingly recognized by health advocates who note that community-based treatment supports both individual recovery and broader public health goals. By providing

structured care outside of hospital settings, facilities can reduce barriers related to cost, accessibility, and time commitments while still ensuring patients receive clinically guided treatment.

As the prevalence of anxiety-related conditions continues to rise, outpatient programs in Southern California are being positioned as a critical part of the mental health care system. Moment of Clarity's Long Beach location reflects this shift by maintaining a focus on evidence-based therapies, structured program design, and integration of both traditional and emerging approaches.
