Overfertilization may burn turf, and improper pruning can leave plants vulnerable to disease. Sustainability is also shaping how Louisiana communities approach landscape care. Water conservation, organic soil treatments, and native plant selections are increasingly common. Ulery said these practices are both environmentally sound and cost-effective. ?When we choose the right plants for the right location and manage resources responsibly, property owners save money over time while supporting healthier communities.?

Landscaping has also become an important factor in storm preparation. In Central, properties often endure heavy rains and wind during hurricane season. Healthy lawns and trees reduce erosion, limit pooling water, and minimize storm damage. For commercial sites, preventive maintenance helps reduce repair costs and downtime after severe weather.

For residents deciding whether to manage fall care themselves or hire professionals, consistency and expertise make the difference. Ulery said that while do-it-yourself efforts can help in the short term, a structured program produces stronger results. ?When a property is managed with the right practices season after season, you see stronger turf, healthier plants, and a landscape that performs better,? he said.
