According to the U.S. Department of Energy, air leakage accounts for 25 to 40 percent of the energy used for heating and cooling in a typical residence. Properly installed insulation helps reduce this energy loss by creating an air barrier that minimizes thermal transfer between interior and exterior environments.

Energy consumption data from the U.S. Energy Information Administration indicates that space heating and cooling represent the largest portion of energy use in American homes, accounting for roughly 51 percent of total residential energy consumption. Insulation improvements are among the most common energy efficiency upgrades undertaken by homeowners. The Environmental Protection Agency estimates that homeowners can save an average of 15 percent on heating and cooling costs by air sealing their homes and

adding insulation in attics, floors over crawl spaces, and accessible basement rim joists.

The insulation industry has seen steady growth in recent years, driven by building code updates, energy efficiency programs, and increased awareness of the relationship between insulation and utility costs. According to market research firm Grand View Research, the global spray foam insulation market was valued at approximately billions in 2023 and is projected to expand at a compound annual growth rate of 7.8 percent through 2030. Residential construction and renovation projects represent a significant portion of this demand.

The expansion enables the company to serve customers beyond its established service territory.
