The center's multidisciplinary approach combines interventional pain management with physical therapy and rehabilitation services. This integrated treatment model addresses not only the immediate pain but also works to restore proper joint function and prevent future complications. Physical therapy programs focus on strengthening the core and pelvic muscles that support the SI joint, improving flexibility, and correcting postural imbalances that may contribute to ongoing discomfort.
