



## **Schebler Heating and Air Introduces Furnace Repair Services in Clinton, IA**

Schebler Heating and Air has announced the introduction of furnace repair services in Clinton, Iowa. The decision was based on an internal review of service requests and infrastructure needs in the region, with the aim of addressing an increase in demand for heating system maintenance and repair. The expansion reflects broader service planning efforts across Eastern Iowa.

Clinton, located along the Mississippi River, has a mix of residential and commercial properties, many of which feature heating systems that have been in use for decades. According to internal data collected by Schebler Heating and Air, calls related to furnace issues in the area have increased steadily over recent seasons. The trend indicated a growing need for localized repair services, prompting the company to extend its offerings.

"Clinton showed a clear demand for heating system support, and furnace repair requests were a notable part of that pattern," said Lance McDanel, spokesperson for Schebler Heating and Air. "We have adjusted our operations to provide those services directly within the community."

The introduction of furnace repair services includes the allocation of additional technician hours to the Clinton area, adjustments to dispatch scheduling, and the stocking of service vehicles with parts commonly needed for furnace repairs. These steps were designed to ensure that field staff could respond effectively to the types of issues most frequently reported in Clinton homes and businesses.

Among the repair concerns identified in the review were units struggling with inconsistent heating, frequent cycling, or reduced overall performance. In some cases, systems had reached or exceeded their expected operational lifespan, leading to a higher likelihood of service interruptions. Calls of this nature were found to be more frequent in older housing areas, while newer developments generated a different set of requests, often centered on system adjustments or maintenance checks.

Commercial properties in Clinton also contributed to the decision to introduce furnace repair services. Mixed-use facilities, office buildings, and small businesses often rely on central heating systems that present different challenges compared to single-family residences. Addressing these calls required both technician availability and preparation specific to commercial system configurations.

To track the effectiveness of the new service introduction, Schebler Heating and Air will monitor several internal metrics, including average response times, rate of first-visit completions, and recurring service requests. The data will be used to assess whether further adjustments are needed as the company evaluates the performance of furnace repair services in the area.

McDanel noted that the expansion into Clinton was part of a larger initiative to review service availability across Eastern Iowa communities. "We're taking a careful look at where demand is highest and what types of systems are most in need of repair," he said. "Clinton stood out during that process, which is why furnace repair was prioritized here."

The addition of furnace repair services in Clinton reflects a growing emphasis on tailoring service offerings to specific regional needs. Rather than applying uniform service models across all communities, Schebler Heating and Air has sought to identify patterns in call distribution and system age, using that information to guide decisions about resource allocation.

As the company begins offering furnace repair in Clinton, the broader regional review continues. Other communities are being evaluated using the same criteria, with adjustments expected where trends indicate that service demand is concentrated or system conditions warrant more focused attention.

By introducing furnace repair services in Clinton, Schebler Heating and Air has taken a step toward

addressing a documented need in the community while continuing to refine its approach to service planning across Eastern Iowa. The changes underscore the importance of adapting to local infrastructure conditions and responding to service data in order to maintain consistency across multiple service regions.
