MYLO solves this problem because it can be used to store bookmarks for any web pages, not just Custom GPT's."

MYLO completely replaces the built in Chrome toolbar functionality for saving and storing bookmarks.

Bookmarks can be stored in users' personal Google Drives so they are available on any computer with Google drive access. Totally private. Power users hunting for a bookmark manager that feels invisible yet indispensable will find Mylo hard to beat. The lightweight browser extension installs in seconds on Chrome, then supercharges the familiar bookmark feature into a full-featured link organizer. Each click lets the user save links, add detailed notes, assign multiple tags, and drop pages into more than one folder, delivering a structured yet flexible knowledge vault. Misplaced an article, or a web page, or even a PDF that want to easily access online. Hit the instant search bar to find a saved bookmark by title, creator, or keyword. Tag and note-level queries are on the way. Unlike basic bookmark lists, Mylo emphasizes secure, cross-device sync so research, tutorials, and dev docs stay at the user's fingertips. For business owners and professionals (like lawyers and CPAs and consultants) this productivity tool ends the endless scrolling and duplicate folders, giving uncluttered focus and truly managed bookmarks.
