



Pleasant Vine Home Care Announces Wilmington, Delaware Office to Serve New Castle and Kent Counties

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Pleasant Vine Home Care is pleased to announce the opening of a new office in Wilmington, Delaware, which will support the expansion of person-centered home and community support services throughout New Castle County and Kent County. The new location, accessible via this map: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/JUe8ERFvKRjfAvxh8>, is intended to enhance responsiveness, local presence, and coordination across the region.

With the addition of the Wilmington office, Pleasant Vine Home Care further strengthens its ability to provide non-medical home care, in-home and community support, and residential habilitation (Community Living Arrangements, or CLA) across Delaware and Pennsylvania. According to the Pleasant Vine Home Care website, the organization is committed to offering services that support independence, dignity, and person-centered care.

The expanded presence in Delaware is timely. Demographic trends point to an increasing population of older

adults and individuals with disabilities who prefer to remain in their homes while receiving assistance. Through local operations in Wilmington, care coordination can become more efficient, travel times for caregivers reduced, and partnerships with health systems, hospitals, community organizations, and government agencies in Delaware better cultivated. The Wilmington office provides a regional anchor to support such alignment.

Pleasant Vine Home Care's suite of services includes non-medical home care, homemaker support, light housekeeping, personal care, companionship, and in-home and community support (including ODP services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities). Residential habilitation and Community Living Arrangements are also core elements of the care model, designed to foster community inclusion, life skills, and autonomy for individuals with developmental disabilities.

The Wilmington office will serve as a local point for oversight, quality assurance, scheduling, and community relationship building, complementing the organization's existing headquarters in Norristown, Pennsylvania. A Delaware-based contact number will enable more direct service coordination for clients, families, referral partners, and other stakeholders in the region.

Community partners and referral sources in Wilmington and surrounding Delaware counties have expressed optimism about the new presence. The office is expected to facilitate smoother transitions from hospitals, rehabilitation centers, and institutional care settings back to home environments, especially when discharge planning includes home support. Local aging agencies, disability support organizations, and social service programs anticipate closer coordination, faster response times, and stronger alignment with local standards, regulations, and networks.

Talent recruitment and workforce engagement also play a pivotal role in the expansion. The new office will prioritize hiring and training of caregivers, support staff, and care coordinators from within the Delaware region, thereby rooting operations in local knowledge and cultural awareness. Pleasant Vine Home Care supports competitive wages, flexible scheduling, and supportive workplace policies aimed at sustaining caregiver retention and job satisfaction.

Through the Wilmington location, operational priorities will include enhanced access to home care options, improved coverage across the service area, coordinated collaboration with Delaware licensing and oversight entities, and strengthened partnerships with health care and social support agencies. Success metrics may encompass reductions in caregiver travel time, improved scheduling efficiency, higher client satisfaction scores, and deeper community integration.

By establishing a permanent presence in Wilmington, Pleasant Vine Home Care signals a long-term commitment to the state of Delaware. The office aligns with broader shifts in health and social care toward

home- and community-based support, as demand grows for alternatives to institutional settings. With closer proximity to clients, oversight, and stakeholders, the capacity to deliver consistent, person-centered care is expected to be elevated.

Awareness efforts and outreach activities will commence to introduce local communities, caregivers, referral sources, and public agencies to the Wilmington office, its service offerings, and processes for coordination.
