



## **Pennsylvania Seamless Gutter Contractor Announces Autumn Gutter Installation Initiative**

Performance Seamless Gutters, an exterior contractor operating in the Pittsburgh region for 24 years, has announced an autumn gutter installation campaign for Pennsylvania homeowners. The initiative focuses on seamless gutter systems with leaf guard protection ahead of the fall season.

The campaign targets homeowners in western Pennsylvania communities including the greater Pittsburgh area, Beaver County, and Butler County. Current weather conditions in Pennsylvania have created installation opportunities before the autumn leaf fall and seasonal precipitation increases, according to the company. The timing of the initiative aligns with the period before trees begin dropping leaves and before temperatures become less favorable for exterior installation work.

The initiative emphasizes seamless gutter systems as an alternative to sectional gutter designs. Seamless gutters are manufactured on-site from continuous material and custom-fitted to each property's measurements, eliminating the joints found in sectional systems where leaks and debris accumulation

typically occur. The on-site fabrication process allows for precise measurements tailored to each home's specific dimensions and architectural features.

"With Pennsylvania experiencing above-average rainfall in 2025, homeowners are seeing increased risks of water intrusion and structural damage," said Tim Grech, Owner of Performance Seamless Gutters. "Installing seamless gutters at this time ensures homes remain protected and resilient against the year's ongoing weather challenges."

The continuous design of seamless gutters reduces debris accumulation points compared to sectional systems, which can lower maintenance frequency and costs for homeowners throughout the year. Traditional sectional gutters contain multiple seams and joints that serve as collection points for leaves, twigs, and other debris, particularly during Pennsylvania's autumn season when leaf fall is substantial across the region.

The design also addresses ice dam formation during Pennsylvania winters by facilitating snowmelt drainage. The streamlined construction reduces water pooling that can lead to roof damage during the region's freeze-thaw cycles, which are common throughout the winter months in western Pennsylvania. Ice dams form when melting snow refreezes at the roof's edge, potentially causing water to back up under shingles and into the home's interior.

Performance Seamless Gutters offers leaf guard systems to complement gutter installations, including EZ Flow Gutter Guards and the AluRex Double Pro system. The company holds certification to install the AluRex Double Pro product. These protection systems are designed to work with seamless gutters to reduce the need for regular gutter cleaning and maintenance while allowing water to flow through while blocking leaves and debris.

The company provides multiple seamless gutter profiles to accommodate different architectural styles and requirements. Available options include 5-inch K-style, 6-inch K-style, 6-inch slant-faced, 7-inch commercial gutters, and half-round 6-inch gutters. The continuous design creates a uniform appearance along the roofline. K-style gutters feature a decorative profile that resembles crown molding, while half-round gutters offer a traditional curved appearance often used on historic or colonial-style homes.

Seamless gutters are manufactured from a single sheet of aluminum, copper, or steel material, depending on homeowner preference and budget. The material is formed into the gutter profile using specialized equipment brought to the installation site, ensuring each section is cut to the exact length needed for the home.

With certifications from the Vinyl Siding Institute (VSI), Performance Seamless Gutters also installs JamesHardie siding, LP Smart Siding, IKO Shingles, and Celebright LED lighting systems. The company serves communities throughout western Pennsylvania including New Brighton, Beaver Falls, Butler, New

Castle, Ellwood City, Aliquippa, Coraopolis, and surrounding areas in Beaver County and Butler County.

In addition to gutter installation, the company provides comprehensive exterior services including roofing, siding installation, soffit and fascia work, and LED architectural lighting systems.
