The medication helps clients focus on therapy and other recovery steps instead of the constant cycle of cravings. Common withdrawal symptoms

that Sublocade helps mitigate include insomnia, muscle aches, nausea, runny nose, watery eyes, severe anxiety, and intense cravings.

The article clarifies Medicaid coverage for those seeking treatment in Virginia. ?Virginia?s Medicaid program, also called Cardinal Care, includes Sublocade as a preferred medication for treating OUD. Coverage applies to adults over 18 and is intended to be used as part of a structured treatment plan for opioid withdrawal. Some limitations may apply regarding the number of doses provided within a six-month period.?

For clients with Medicaid, the monthly cost of Sublocade typically ranges from \$1 to \$4, depending on the specific plan. This cost is comparable to Suboxone, which averages around \$3 per month for Medicaid recipients. The article emphasizes the importance of discussing coverage details with a prescribing physician to ensure proper access and dosing.

?Access to medication should not be a barrier to recovery,? the article notes. ?For those without insurance or with commercial plans, costs can vary widely. A good treatment program will work with clients to create an affordable payment plan and ensure they can access the medication they need.?

Cardinal Care is designed for low-income adults, pregnant women, people with disabilities, and individuals who were formerly in foster care. Income eligibility is based on household income, with adults earning \$21,587 or less generally qualifying. Applications can be completed online, by phone, or with a paper form in English or Spanish.

Medication-assisted treatment, including Sublocade, is most effective when paired with therapy and ongoing case management. ReVIDA® Recovery provides outpatient services that help clients manage employment, housing, and basic needs while participating in treatment.
