Key findings include:

The Chevrolet Tahoe averaged nearly 200,000 miles before retirement, 23 percent above the national average.

The Ford Ranger averaged 25.6 years on the road, 50 percent longer than the typical U.S. vehicle lifespan.

Toyota and Honda models accounted for five of the top ten highest-mileage vehicles.

American trucks such as the Ford F-150 and Chevrolet Suburban consistently exceeded national averages in both years and mileage.

The study differs from many commonly cited reports, which often measure potential longevity from active registrations or used car listings. Large SUVs like the Chevrolet Suburban, family minivans like the Honda Odyssey, and hybrids like the Toyota Prius all appear in the top rankings. This suggests that engineering quality and consistent maintenance practices can matter more than vehicle category alone.
