



Vanessa Gallegos Florida Project Expands Boca Raton Community Outreach for Breast Cancer Awareness

The Vanessa Gallegos Florida Project announces expanded community engagement efforts in Boca Raton, Delray Beach, and throughout Palm Beach County in recognition of Breast Cancer Awareness Month. The initiative aims to strengthen partnerships between healthcare providers, nonprofits, and civic organizations to improve access to preventive screenings and education.

With one in eight women facing a breast cancer diagnosis during their lifetime, the project emphasizes the critical importance of early detection and community involvement. Through coordinated outreach efforts, the initiative seeks to connect residents with expanded mammogram services now available at multiple Palm Beach Health Network facilities, including locations in Palm Beach Gardens, Royal Palm Beach, and near Delray Medical Center.

The Vanessa Gallegos Boca Raton Breast Cancer Awareness initiative also promotes participation in the annual Every Boob Counts 5K at South County Regional Park in Boca Raton. This event brings together

survivors, healthcare advocates, and community members for education, connection, and support. Participants gain access to screening information, connect with local healthcare providers, and learn about available resources across Palm Beach County.

The project particularly highlights the Promise Fund of Florida's 31-Day Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Challenge, which calls on medical providers and community organizations across Palm Beach, Broward, and Martin counties to increase screening accessibility throughout October. This challenge represents a significant regional effort to reduce late-stage diagnoses and improve health outcomes for underserved populations.

"Community advocacy plays a vital role in connecting residents with life-saving resources," said Vanessa Gallegos of Boca Raton, founder of the Vanessa Gallegos Florida Project. "Our goal is to ensure that every woman in Palm Beach County has the opportunity to receive life-saving screenings and feel supported throughout the process."

The project utilizes digital platforms to extend its reach and impact. Through Vanessa Gallegos Florida Events Facebook and Project's Instagram, the organization shares updates about screening schedules, educational workshops, and survivor stories. These platforms also feature highlights from community events in Boca Raton and Delray Beach, reinforcing public engagement around women's health and early detection.
