



GrinderCrusherScreen Showcases Forestry Equipment and Parts at the 2025 Paul Bunyan Show

GrinderCrusherScreen, a national supplier of new and used forestry equipment and replacement parts, proudly exhibited at the 2025 Paul Bunyan Show, held October 4-6 at the Guernsey County Fairgrounds in Cambridge, Ohio. Organized by the Ohio Forestry Association, the annual show is one of the leading events for professionals in the forestry, land clearing, mulch production, and wood recycling industries. This year's event drew thousands of attendees from across the country, including logging contractors, sawmill operators, grinding and screening crews, and equipment mechanics.

GrinderCrusherScreen used the three-day event to highlight its growing role in supplying quality used equipment, sourcing new machines, and providing fast, reliable access to forestry wear parts. Company representatives engaged with contractors and equipment operators who rely on horizontal grinders, trommel screens, and material handling systems to support daily operations. The company's team was on site to answer questions about machine availability, equipment inspections, and parts compatibility across various makes and models. The response was strong, with many attendees expressing the same concern finding affordable, reliable equipment and getting replacement parts without the long lead times typically associated with original manufacturers.

Throughout the event, attendees visited GrinderCrusherScreen's booth to learn more about their extensive inventory and parts department. Many contractors shared the challenge of keeping older machines running without delays caused by hard-to-find components. GrinderCrusherScreen addressed this head-on, explaining how the company stocks and sources critical forestry parts including grinder tips, shredder knives, screen sections, bolts, nuts, wear plates, holders, bearings, and conveyor belts. By offering parts for both newer equipment and discontinued models, the company helps contractors avoid downtime and stay on schedule. Attendees were especially interested in the availability of in-stock grinder tips and shredder components, which are known for wearing out quickly in high-production environments.

Conversations with buyers also revealed growing interest in used horizontal grinders, trommel screens, and portable conveyors. Many crews are preparing for winter production or planning equipment upgrades for 2026. GrinderCrusherScreen emphasized that all machines listed on their website are inspected and ready to ship. Attendees were able to review product photos, machine specs, and transport options directly with staff during the show. This allowed for meaningful conversations about real equipment needs and helped potential buyers take the next step in planning their fleet additions.

One of the highlights of the Paul Bunyan Show was the live equipment demonstration area. Dozens of machines, including grinders, chippers, and screening systems, operated throughout the weekend. GrinderCrusherScreen team members observed these demos and spoke with vendors about updates in engine performance, feed system design, and fuel efficiency. These insights are vital in helping the company recommend the right machine for each customer's production goals. Watching the machines run in real time also helps validate the performance of different brands and models that are frequently listed on GrinderCrusherScreen's site.

Another major talking point during the event was parts availability. Many contractors voiced frustration over long wait times, unreturned calls, or parts arriving that don't fit their machines. GrinderCrusherScreen responded by outlining how their parts department works quickly to verify fit, locate inventory, and arrange fast shipping. With a growing nationwide network and multiple storage locations, the company has positioned itself as a go-to source for forestry machine wear parts. Customers benefit from faster turnaround times and expert support from staff who understand how the machines operate in real working conditions.

Beyond sales and service, the Paul Bunyan Show plays a key role in industry education and training. GrinderCrusherScreen supports the Ohio Forestry Association's mission to promote safety, productivity, and sustainability in forestry operations. This year's show included tree felling competitions, sawmill skills demonstrations, youth engagement activities, and training sessions for machine operators and mechanics.
