"From establishing feeding routines that allow both babies to eat efficiently, to managing different sleep patterns, to ensuring each baby receives individual attention and bonding time, multiple-birth care demands specialized knowledge that not all newborn care specialists possess."

Specialists help establish systems including strategies for tandem nursing, efficient bottle-feeding techniques, proper milk storage and labeling systems, and schedules that allow adequate parental rest.

Sleep management requires specialized expertise because twins and multiples often have different sleep patterns and needs. Specialists assess each baby's individual needs and help families implement approaches that promote healthy sleep for all babies while maximizing parental rest.

Even identical twins develop at different rates and have distinct personalities. Specialists trained in multiple-birth care understand the importance of treating each baby as an individual, tracking developmental milestones separately, recognizing when differences warrant pediatric consultation, providing appropriate stimulation for each baby's developmental stage, and helping parents bond with each child individually.

The physical demands of caring for multiples can lead to parental exhaustion and increased risk of postpartum mood disorders. Specialists provide crucial support by ensuring parents get adequate sleep and

recovery time, offering practical assistance with the physical demands of infant care, providing emotional support and validation during challenging moments, and recognizing warning signs of postpartum anxiety or depression that require professional intervention.

Understanding that families with multiples have diverse needs and circumstances, The NCS Agency offers flexible care arrangements. Most families with twins work with one highly trained specialist, particularly for overnight care. For higher-order multiples, the agency can arrange multiple specialists working coordinated schedules. Some families utilize a primary overnight specialist supplemented by daytime postpartum doula support. Families may need intensive support during the immediate postpartum period with the option to scale back as parents gain confidence.

"Our goal isn't to create dependence on professional care?it's to give parents the tools, confidence, and rest they need to thrive with their multiples," Sakowicz said. "By the time our specialists transition out, families should feel empowered and equipped to continue the routines and strategies we've established together."

Early engagement allows families to establish relationships with potential specialists, develop care plans aligned with their goals, prepare their home environment, and reduce stress by having support systems confirmed in advance.
