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The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration issued its 2025-2026 winter outlook on October 16, indicating colder-than-normal temperatures across the upper Midwest. This forecast aligns with ongoing concerns about winter weather impacts on roofing, where heavy snow and ice accumulation contribute to structural strain. According to the Insurance Information Institute, winter storms caused \$4 billion in insured losses in 2018, \$2 billion in 2019 and \$1.1 billion in subsequent years, with significant portions affecting Midwest properties through roof damage and related claims.

DaVinci composite roofing products consist of synthetic materials designed to replicate natural slate and cedar shake, including variants such as DaVinci Cedar Shake and DaVinci Slate. These composites demonstrate resistance to warping, rotting and cracking under conditions like extreme temperature variations, high winds and precipitation common in the Midwest. Tested by licensed independent laboratories, the products achieve a Class A fire rating per ASTM E108 specifications, a Class 4 impact rating and wind resistance up to 110 mph, supporting their application in severe weather zones.

The company issues workmanship warranties ranging from 25 to 50 years, contingent on material selection, with backing from manufacturers including Owens Corning and GAF.
