



Amana Care Clinic - Davenport Introduces Enhanced Virtual Care Platform for Urgent Medical Services

Amana Care Clinic - Davenport has introduced an enhanced virtual care platform that enables patients throughout the Quad Cities region to access urgent medical services through secure online video consultations, expanding the facility's capacity to serve non-emergency healthcare needs beyond traditional walk-in visits.

The Davenport health clinic launched the digital consultation service in response to data indicating that regional emergency departments continue to experience significant volume from patients seeking treatment for non-emergency conditions. The platform allows certified healthcare providers to evaluate and treat conditions including respiratory infections, skin conditions, urinary tract infections, and minor injuries through secure video appointments.

"The integration of virtual care technology represents a significant advancement in how we deliver urgent medical services to the Quad Cities community," said Dr. Moutaz Kotob, Medical Director at Amana Care

Clinic - Davenport. "This platform enables us to evaluate and treat patients who may have difficulty traveling to our facility while maintaining the same standard of care we provide during in-person visits."

The urgent care clinic maintains comprehensive diagnostic capabilities at its physical location, including laboratory testing and X-ray imaging equipment. Patients requiring diagnostic services or hands-on treatment can schedule same-day walk-in visits, while those with conditions suitable for remote evaluation can access care through the virtual platform. Common conditions treated include cold and flu symptoms, ear infections, rashes, sinus infections, and minor burns.

The virtual care platform operates alongside the clinic's established walk-in services, which remain available seven days per week with extended hours. Patients can choose between immediate walk-in visits, online reservations for specific arrival times, or virtual consultations based on their medical needs and preferences. The multi-channel approach addresses varying patient circumstances and medical requirements.

Healthcare utilization data from the Iowa Department of Public Health indicates that urgent care facilities in the region treated over 150,000 non-emergency cases in the previous year, representing a 12 percent increase from prior periods. The introduction of virtual care capabilities at facilities like Amana Care Clinic - Davenport aligns with statewide initiatives to expand healthcare access through technology integration.

The clinic's virtual platform includes features for secure document sharing, prescription management, and follow-up scheduling. Patients receive treatment plans and medical documentation through the secure portal, maintaining continuity of care between virtual and in-person visits. The system integrates with existing electronic health records to ensure comprehensive medical history tracking.

Insurance coverage for virtual consultations mirrors that of traditional office visits for most major carriers operating in Iowa. The clinic provides transparent pricing information for self-pay patients and offers multiple payment methods including health savings account processing.

The expansion of virtual care services addresses identified gaps in regional healthcare access, particularly for patients in rural areas surrounding the Quad Cities who may face transportation challenges when seeking treatment at a hospital for non-emergency conditions. The service also provides an alternative for patients with mobility limitations or those seeking to minimize exposure during seasonal illness peaks.

Amana Care Clinic - Davenport serves as a comprehensive urgent care provider for the Quad Cities region, including communities in Davenport and Muscatine, Iowa. The facility employs certified healthcare professionals trained in urgent care medicine and utilizes diagnostic equipment including digital X-ray

systems and CLIA-certified laboratory facilities. The clinic treats a range of non-emergency medical conditions including fractures, lacerations, respiratory infections, and provides services such as sports physicals and occupational health screenings.
