Property owners can take steps to prevent such issues, including insulating pipes in unheated areas, allowing faucets to drip during extreme cold, and maintaining consistent indoor temperatures. If damage occurs, professional intervention helps address water extraction, drying, and repairs to prevent secondary problems like mold growth.

Heating systems also pose risks during winter. Improper use or maintenance of furnaces, space heaters, and fireplaces can lead to fires, resulting in smoke and soot damage throughout a property.
