The 2000 Porsche 911 Carrera 4 Convertible is presented in Silver with a Gray leather interior and a Black

automatic convertible top. It is powered by a 3.4-liter flat-six engine paired with an automatic transmission, and it shows 60,416 miles. The vehicle includes Porsche's all-wheel-drive system, known for providing improved road grip and stability under varying conditions. The convertible top operates smoothly, and the interior features heated seats and power windows, aligning with the practical yet performance-oriented approach typical of Porsche's design philosophy during this period.

This example, originally from Florida, has had four owners and was garage-kept. Its maintenance record includes completion of the 60,000-mile service, indicating attention to factory-recommended upkeep. The Silver paintwork remains in well-preserved condition, and the cabin retains its original finishes. With its mileage, service documentation, and overall state of preservation, the vehicle reflects the consistent durability associated with the 996 generation.

The 996 generation of the Porsche 911, produced from 1999 through 2004, marked the first time Porsche utilized a water-cooled engine in its flagship sports car. The 3.4-liter flat-six introduced a new level of thermal efficiency and performance balance while retaining the 911's rear-engine configuration. The Carrera 4 variant added all-wheel drive to the mix, improving handling precision and control without sacrificing the model's familiar dynamics.

This era of the 911 remains significant to Porsche's development as a brand. The shift to water cooling represented a major technical evolution that would shape all future iterations of the 911 platform. The combination of engineering refinement, aerodynamic improvements, and modern interior appointments made the 996 generation a versatile sports car suitable for both everyday driving and longer-distance touring.

The 2000 Porsche 911 Carrera 4 Convertible listed by Classic Car Deals illustrates these characteristics in detail. The car maintains a clean presentation inside and out, consistent with long-term private ownership and careful use. The vehicle's mechanical configuration provides balanced performance suitable for a range of driving environments, and its preserved condition aligns with the standards expected by those seeking documented, well-maintained vehicles.
