The 1964 Dart GT, finished in White with a Blue interior, is a two-door hardtop coupe identified under Stock #CCD167. The vehicle has undergone a recent restoration that included an engine and transmission

overhaul. The 318 V8 delivers the smooth torque response typical of Dodge small-block engines, while the push-button automatic transmission contributes to the car's mechanical originality. The addition of four-wheel disc brakes modernizes its braking capability, improving stopping performance compared to the original drum brake setup.

This model year represents one of the transitional periods in Dodge's compact performance development. The Dart GT combined the size efficiency of a smaller frame with features that appealed to drivers interested in performance handling and styling. The push-button transmission was a notable innovation at the time, integrating functionality and novelty while maintaining a connection to Chrysler's broader engineering direction during that decade.

The restoration of this vehicle emphasizes mechanical dependability while retaining the visual and structural character associated with the original design. The car's exterior finish, brightwork, and trim have been maintained to reflect the correct period appearance, while the Blue interior presents the color combinations characteristic of the early 1960s model range. The updates performed on this Dart GT were intended to preserve its usability while sustaining the aesthetic and technical identity of the original design.

Classic Car Deals lists the vehicle with a clear title and provides comprehensive details including photographs, video documentation, and specifications. The listing, priced at \$34,995, includes a walkaround video available on their website , which provides additional visual information regarding the car's condition.
