Layer order and weight vary by model, producing a range of tactile responses while avoiding heavy synthetic foams.

Model families cover multiple firmness profiles and tensions, including split-tension configurations for partners with different needs. Pocket-spring layouts may incorporate zoning, where coil diameter or wire gauge changes across shoulder, lumbar, and hip regions to encourage alignment. Height profiles, topper options, and paired divan bases enable further tuning. Headboards and bases rely on robust joinery and natural materials, supporting mattress geometry and ventilation rather than relying on cosmetic padding.

Sustainability considerations extend throughout material selection and assembly. Renewable, biodegradable fibers reduce reliance on petrochemical inputs; long service life lowers replacement frequency; hand

assembly limits certain industrial adhesives and supports refurbishment practices. Fiber provenance and animal-welfare standards inform sourcing decisions, reflecting rising expectations around traceability.
