These types of issues are sometimes mistaken for mechanical failure but can often be corrected through recalibration or replacement of the thermostat.

Key parts such as burners, flame sensors, and limit switches can become coated with debris over time, leading to inefficient operation or system shutdowns. Without regular maintenance, these problems often go undetected until noticeable performance issues develop.
