



Olympic Weight Set With 7FT Barbell Collection Unveiled by Strongway Gym Supplies

"The updates we've made are about presenting a clearer structure so users can build around the essentials and add to their setup at a pace that suits them."

The company added that the release supports an ongoing development plan for its weight collections, with further updates scheduled throughout the year.

Strongway noted that the home fitness sector continues to mature, driven by individuals who prefer consistent, versatile equipment that performs well across long-term routines. Many users, the company said, now invest in complete plate and bar combinations rather than individual items, especially when following structured strength programmes.
