Battery performance remains a top concern in cold climates. Low temperatures can reduce a battery's capacity by nearly half, particularly in older units. Testing or replacing batteries before the onset of freezing

conditions can prevent starting issues. Tire maintenance is equally critical; adequate tread depth and proper inflation provide traction on icy roads, while dedicated winter tires improve braking and handling when temperatures drop below 45 degrees Fahrenheit.

Windshield wiper fluid rated for winter use prevents freezing, ensuring visibility in slush and snow. Checking antifreeze levels and brake systems is essential to avoid mechanical strain, while ensuring that heaters and defrosters function properly maintains both driver comfort and window clarity.

"Michigan drivers face some of the most challenging winter conditions in the country, and preparing vehicles in advance helps ensure they perform reliably when needed most," said Matt Sloan, General Manager at Graff Chevrolet-Okemos. "We encourage vehicle owners to schedule seasonal maintenance to identify issues before the first major snowfall arrives."

Alignment checks are another essential step as potholes and rough road conditions during winter can cause uneven tire wear and reduced control. Clean, functional headlights and taillights further enhance visibility and safety on shorter, darker winter days.

"Proactive maintenance is not just about vehicle longevity—it's about safety," Alaniz noted. "Drivers who take time to prepare now are less likely to face unexpected issues when road conditions are at their worst."
