A comprehensive analysis by LendingTree documented that billion-dollar winter disasters have increased 135.5% over the past 20 years, with damage from billion-dollar severe storms jumping 716.8% from \$10.0 billion to \$81.7 billion between 1985-2004 and 2005-2024. Ice storms alone account for more than 60 percent of winter storm losses within the United States, with a mean total annual cost of \$226 million.?

Trees in the Delaware region remain particularly vulnerable during the winter months. Ice accumulation on branches can increase load stress on tree structures, while high winds and heavy snow further compromise weakened limbs and root systems. Research conducted by Morton Arboretum has documented how ice storms cause significant damage to trees in natural and urban settings through ice build-up patterns on branches that predispose trees to failure.?

"Early detection of structural issues is critical," according to guidance from professional arboricultural standards. A winter tree inspection provides an opportunity to identify hazards when trees are in dormancy and foliage has fallen away, making structural defects far more visible. According to the International Society of Arboriculture (ISA), the professional standard for tree risk assessment is the ISA Tree Risk Assessment Qualification (ISA TRAQ), which employs a standardized, systematic process for assessing tree risk and providing information to property owners.?
